Then we went for the camel safari where the uninterrupted golden stretch of the desert gave us an exotic feeling. Slowly the sun weakened down the horizon which was worth a snapshot.

Then we visited Gadisan lake and Ramdevra temple. on route. We reached Kota on the morning of 20th Oct.

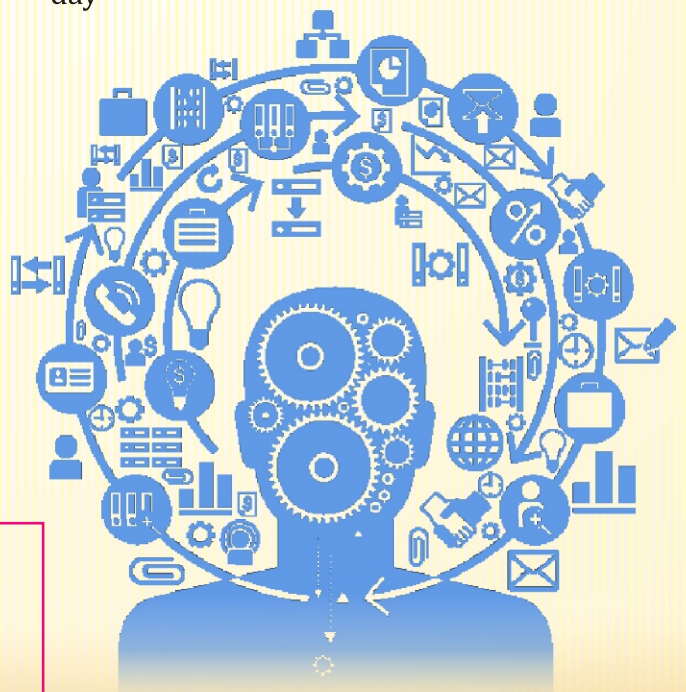

But silent, and not telling anything in brief.

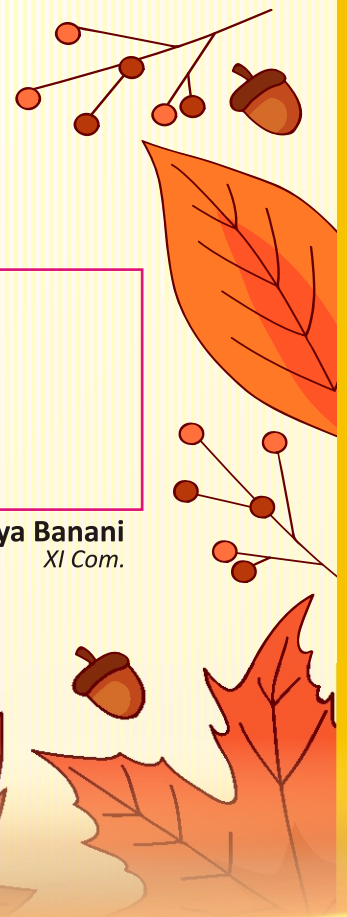

चन्द्रयान-2

भारत का अकाल्पनिक : गौरवपूर्ण मिशन

अंतरिक्ष आदिकाल से मनुष्य के लिए जिज्ञासा का केन्द्र रहा है। अंतरिक्ष के गूढ़ रहस्यों को जानने और समझने की प्रबल इच्छा मनुष्यों में हमेशा से रही है। अंतरिक्ष के अनेक रहस्यमयी ग्रहों व उपग्रहों में से एक चंद्रमा (पृथ्वी का उपग्रह) हमेशा से ही हमारी पौराणिक कथाओं का अभिन्न अंग रहा है। सन् 1969 में पहली बार मानव ने इस उपग्रह पर अपना कदम रखा था। सन् 1969 से आज तक चंद्रमा की सतह पर अनेक अंतरिक्ष यान प्रक्षेपित किए हैं।

भारत द्वारा सन् 2008 में चंद्रयान-1 मिशन के तहत चंद्रयान-1 अंतरिक्ष यान चंद्रमा की सतह पर प्रक्षेपित किया गया था। इस मिशन के दस वर्षों के उपरांत भारतीय अंतरिक्ष अनुसंधान संगठन (इसरो) ने भूस्थिर उपग्रह प्रक्षेपण यान संस्करण-III (GSLV-MK-III) से 22 जुलाई 2019 को, 02:43 अपरान्ह, श्रीहरिकोटा रेंज से चंद्रयान-2 का सफल प्रक्षेपण किया। यह मिशन पूर्णतः स्वनिर्मित व स्वदेशी तकनीक से अत्यंत ही कम लागत में सफलतापूर्वक पूर्ण किया गया।

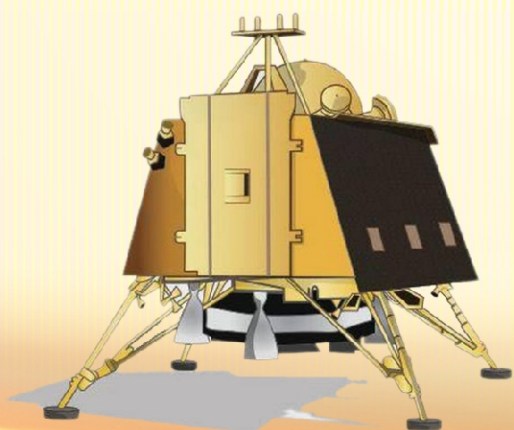
इसका मुख्य उद्देश्य चाँद के वातावरण व पानी का विश्लेषण करना है। इसमें उच्च रेजोल्यूशन डिजिटल कैमरा व रडार लगे हैं जिससे चाँद के सूक्ष्म तत्वों का गहराई से अध्ययन किया जा सके। इसका लैंडर और रोवर चंद्रमा पर लगभग 70 डिग्री दक्षिण के अक्षांश पर स्थित दो क्रेटरों 'मजिनस सी और सिमपेलियस एन' के बीच उच्च मैदान पर उतरने का प्रयास करेगा। इसमें तेरह पेलोड हैं। जिनमें भारत के पाँच व अमेरिका के दो शामिल हैं। इसमें तीन मॉड्यूल भी हैं - कक्षयान, लैंडर (विक्रम), रोवर (प्रज्ञान)।

इसरो का यह पहला मिशन है जिसमें लैंडर जाएगा व सॉफ्ट लैंडिंग करेगा। यह 2 मीटर प्रति सैकण्ड की गति से चंद्रमा की सतह पर उतरेगा। यह चंद्रमा की झीलों को मापेगा व लूनर कृष्ट की खुदाई करेगा। रोवर लैंडर से जुड़ा रहेगा। जब लैंडर लैंड करेगा तो रोवर लैंडर से बाहर आकर चंद्रमा की मिट्टी का रासायनिक विश्लेषण करेगा। रोवर सोलर पेनलो की सहायता से अपने लिए ऊर्जा उत्पन्न करेगा। यह पन्द्रह दिनों तक चंद्रमा की सतह का विश्लेषण करेगा।

चंद्रयान-2 का सबसे महत्वपूर्ण मॉड्यूल 'ऑर्बिटर' (कक्षयान) चाँद की कक्षा में चक्कर लगाता रहेगा और लैंडर और रोवर से सिग्नल पृथ्वी पर पहुँचाता रहेगा।

यह अभियान लगभग पूर्णतः सफल था परन्तु 7 सितम्बर 2019, रात्रि 1:52 बजे लैंडर लैंडिंग से लगभग 2.1 कि. मी. दूरी पर अपने इच्छित पथ से भटक गया। यह घटना न सिर्फ भारतीयों अथवा पूरे विश्व के लोगों के लिए शोकपूर्ण थी।

इसरो ने 8 सितम्बर, 2019 को कक्षयान द्वारा लिए गए उष्माचित्र से विक्रम लैंडर का चंद्रमा की सतह पर पता लगाया। यह लैंडिंग भले ही सफलतापूर्वक न हो पाई हो परन्तु कक्षयान आज भी चंद्रमा के दक्षिण भाग के चित्र भेज रहा है। यह सभी भारत वासियों के लिए गर्व का विषय है।
